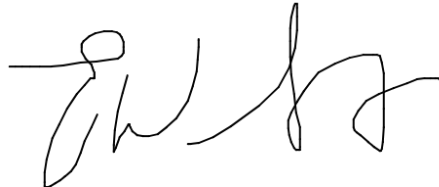

The Court applied INA sec. 236(a), Matter of Guerra, 24 I&N Dec. 37 (BIA 2006), and cases cited therein in reaching this decision. DHS did not meet its burden to show by clear and convincing evidence that Respondent's risk of flight is such that no alternative to detention requirements can address it, and analyzed Respondent's ability to pay in setting the conditions. A full memorandum will be provided at a later date if needed.
